Term	Definition	Skills ✓
All Apps Button	A button located in the Start menu that opens an alphabetical list of installed apps on your PC.	
Context Menu	A menu that opens by clicking an item once with the right mouse button. Keyboard users may press the <b>APPLICATION</b> key or <b>SHIFT+F10</b> . Items in the context menu may vary depending on what is available at the time it is invoked.	
Desktop List View	A group of items arranged in rows, columns, or both, with text labels and/or icons.	
Start Button	The first button on the Taskbar. It is used to open the Start menu.	
System Tray	The right corner of the Taskbar, officially called the "Notification Area," where buttons for running apps and services appear alongside the buttons for Internet access and Speakers and Headphones.	
Taskbar	The bottom row of the Windows screen which contains buttons for launching apps as well as buttons for apps running in the System Tray.	
Taskbar Corner	The right side of the Taskbar, including the Show Hidden Icons button and other buttons for running apps as well as the buttons for Internet access and Speakers and Headphones.
