Breadcrumb	A horizontal list of buttons near the top of the	
Buttons	main part of the Settings app used for navigating to prior settings pages opened during a session.	
More Button	A button that visually looks like a "greater than" sign but is in tab order and can be accessed via the mouse or keyboard.	
Radio Buttons	A group of buttons allowing only one item to be selected at a time from the available choices. Selecting one radio button deselects any prior selection and changes focus to the new one.	
Slider Control	A vertical or horizontal control with increments that range from smaller on one end of the control to larger on the other end. The volume slider bar is an example.	
Time Picker Buttons	Buttons for setting the start and end times for various processes in the Windows Settings app.	
Widget	A unique small application that can be opened to perform specific actions within a host app. An example is the time picker widget used for setting hours and minutes for Focus Assist automatic rules.
